The Producer:

A "costa" is the side of a hill that faces the sun; "Russi" is the nickname of the former owners of this vineyard, which was then acquired in 1967 by Gaja family.

The Wine:

Grape(s):	100% Nebbiolo
Area:	The vineyard is just few steps below Sori' Tildin in the village of Barbaresco and enjoys a southwestern exposure.
Surface:	11 hectares. The soil is primarily marl, clay and limestone.
Vinification:	Fermentation and maceration in stainless steel tanks for three weeks.
Ageing:	The wine is aged for twelve months in barriques, followed by an additional twelve months of aging in large oak casks.

Tasting Notes:

- This wine shows elegance, ripe fruit and a velvety structure from an early age, with well-integrated aromas of blackberries, violets and roasted coffee beans. Full body with great concentration and purity.
