Surface: 11 hectares. The soil is primarily marl, clay and limestone.

Vinification: Fermentation and maceretion in stainless steel tanks for three

weeks.

Ageing: The wine is aged for twelve months in barriques, followed by an

additional twelve months of aging in large oak casks.
