

AOP Côtes du Rhône Magie d'Une Terre La Cave Les Coteaux du Rhône



The Producer:

The Cotes du Rhone has been a significant wine producing area since the Romans colonised France after entering from Marseilles. The wines represent excellent value for money. The winery is a co-operative that was begun in 1926 and is situated just north of the town of Orange in the Vaucluse department.

The Wine:

Grape(s): Grenache Syrah Carignan Mouvedre
Area: From vineyards around the town of Serignan du Comtat just north of Orange.
Vines per ha.: 4,000 per ha.
Yield: 50 hl/ha
Av. age of vines: 15-30 years old
Vinification: There is a 24 hour thermovinification and a 2 week maceration followed by a fermentation at 28°C for about a week. There is a full malolactic fermentation.
Ageing: Aged in concrete vats until bottling

Tasting Notes:

- A lovely firm berry fruit nose. On the palate a classically well structured Rhone flavor, a touch of crispness in middle palate and followed by a softly dry finish.
