The Proemio winery (medieval Spanish for, Prologue) was established in 2001by Marcelo Bocardo, a third-generation winemaker and descendant of a family of Italian immigrants, and is producing a wide range of wines of great quality. Argentina's wines from the Malbec grape have established themselves as one of Britain's most popular red wines in recent years as Argentina clearly has the ideal growing conditions, particularly in the Mendoza region, for what in the past was an under-rated grape.
