

## Malbec Mendoza - Proemio Wines

### The Producer:

The Proemio winery (medieval Spanish for, Prologue) was established in 2001 by Marcelo Bocardo, third generation winemaker and descendant of a family of Italian immigrants, and is producing a wide range of wines of great quality. Argentina's wines from the Malbec grape have established themselves as one of Britain's most popular red wines in recent years as Argentina clearly has the ideal growing conditions, particularly in the Mendoza region, for what in the past was an under-rated grape.

### The Wine:

Grape(s): 100% Malbec  
Area: From grapes grown in vineyards in the Maipu region of Mendoza at around 2,600.  
Age of the vines: 10 years old.  
Ageing: 6 months in bottle

### Tasting Notes:

- A ripe plum laden nose with intensity. On the palate its rich, firm fruit fills the mouth and with touches of blackcurrant it has a lovely long, soley dry, fruity finish.
