## The Producer:

This is the outstanding wine of the Campania region in southern Italy. Centred on the village of Taurasi the wine is made from the ancient variety of Aglianico, a grape that is ideally suited to the volcanic soil of the region, home as it is to Naples and Mount Vesuvius. Regarded by many as a variety to be compared with nebbiolo from Piemonte or sangiovese from Tuscany it is probably of Greek origin. A good sunny climate and good hillside vineyards make Campania an ideal region for producing top quality wines.

Grape(s): Aglianico 100%

Area: From vineyards in Montemarano in Taurasi

Vine density: 2,500 – 3,000 per ha.

Training System: Cordon Spur

Ageing: Two years in large Slavonian and French barriques and a further

year in bottle

## Tasting Notes:

- A rich nose redolent of figs and tobacco, a good flavour on the palate good fruit and followed by a firm, dry finish.
- Taurasi is thought by many to be Italy's next great wine waiting to happen. From vineyards planted in the volcanic soils around the town of Taurasi, in the hills inland from Naples, using the local grape Aglianico this is a great wine. A rich nose redolent of figs and tobacco, a good flavour on the palate good fruit and followed by a firm, dry finish
