The Producer:

Moulin de Gassac is the off-spring of one of France's most highly regarded producers, Mas de Daumas Gassac. The Moulin de Gassac range of wines were established in the early 1990s by Aime Guilbert, the founder of Mas de Daumas Gassac. They are from the vineyards in the amphitheatre behind the Etang de Thau, centred on the town of Pinet. The grapes from each vineyard parcel are vinified separately and then blended.

The Wine:

Grape(s):	50% Syrah and 50% Carignan
Area:	From vineyards behind the Etang de Thau between Montpellier and Beziers
Yield:	60 hl/ha.
Vinification:	After de-stemming and a soft crushing the wine is fermented in stainless steel vats
Ageing:	Kept in stainless steel vats for 5-6 months before bottling

Tasting Notes:

- A rose pink to almost salmon pink. On the nose floral with mineral tones and on the palate a lively freshness with touches of berry fruit. A good finish.
