

IGP Méditerranée Rosé La Balade de Coline La Cave Les Coteaux du Rhône



The Producer:

Until the 1990s rose wine was essentially something drunk only in the summer and then really only close to where it was made. Since then the quality and range of rose wines has increased dramatically and wine-makers are taking them more seriously. The La Cave Les Coteaux du Rhone is a co-operative and was established in 1926, just north of the town of Orange in the southern Rhone.

The Wine:

Grape(s):	Grenache and Syrah
Area:	From vineyards around the town of Serignan du Comtat, north of Orange
Vines per ha.:	4,000 per ha.
Yield:	70 hl/ha
Av. age of vines:	10-20 years old
Vinification:	The wine is fermented for 2 weeks at 130C. There is no malolactic fermentation.
Ageing:	Aged in stainless steel tanks until bottling

Tasting Notes:

- A light delicate nose with a touch of blossom. In the mouth there is a distinctive herbiness and a crisp, dry finish.
- Rose wine is developing into something that can be drunk on all occasions and this Rhone rose, from just north of the town of Orange, illustrates the point. A light delicate nose with a touch of blossom. In the mouth there is a distinctive herbiness and a crisp, dry finish.
