The Producer:

Chablis is one of France's best known dry, white wines and is famous for its mineraly, steely firmness. L'Homme Mort is a small vineyard or lieux-dit within the Premier Cru of Fourchaume which is considered to be one of the best Chablis Premier Cru. Due to its westerly aspect, L'Homme Mort receives slightly more sunshine than other parts of Fourchaume to make it a fuller style of wine. The macabre name is derived from the fact that in centuries gone by criminals were hanged on a gibbet on the roadside by the vineyard. The Durup family have been established in Chablis for almost 500 years and the Paul Gally name refers to the Jean Durup's grandfather.
