

Meursault Village - Virely-Rougeot



The Producer:

Patrick and Virginie Virely now work the vines and run the winery with Patrick himself the winemaker remaining determined to make Pommard, Meursault and Bourgogne in the family tradition. Agriculture raisonnée is followed along with the strict rules that come with membership of the association of Vignerons indépendants de France including requiring members to work their own vines, make and bottle their own wines on site. Virely-Rougeot's Meursault Village is made with 100% Chardonnay grapes from 3 plots bordering Meursault 1er Cru just to the South of the village: Les Narvaux, Le Limozin and Les Pelles."

The Wine:

Grape(s): 100% Chardonnay
Area: Meursault Village, Côte de Beaune. On the edge of Meursault 1er Cru. 1.4ha
Harvest: Hand harvested
Vinification: Processing is by crusher/de-stemmer. Pressing is followed by settling. Alcoholic fermentation is in oak barrels, through to the end of malo-lactic fermentation.
Vegan: Yes
Organic: No, agriculture raisonnee

Tasting Notes:

An excellent wine with clean and powerful aromas of apples and almonds, on the palate it has well balanced richness and acidity with notes of grapefruit zest, honey and almonds.
