

Rioja Blanco - Loriñon

The Producer:

From Vinicola Real's best plots of viura and garnacha they produce the Loriñon White, a wine that reflects the land and the spirituality of the surroundings of the vineyards, close to the Monasteries of Suso and Yuso and the Cañas Abbey. Vinicola Real is a small winery located in the town of Albelda de Iregua in La Rioja where, with painstaking hard work, the winery has come to produce some excellent high quality wines. With a lot of care, Vinos de Pago has found a medium between new wines from Rioja and traditional crianzas from the area.

The Wine:

Grape(s): 80% Garnacha Blanca and 20% Viura.
Area: Close to the Monasteries of Suso and Yuso and the Cañas Abbey
Harvest: Grapes harvested manually harvested
Vinification: Aged for 14 months in barrels of American and French oak
Ageing: Remains a minimum of 6 months in bottle prior to release.

Tasting Notes:

- The wine has Aromas which are lean and citrusy with notes of lime peel, lemon verbana, marjoram honeydew melon, fresh tarragon, and a chalky mineral note. This wine is a straw yellow in colour.
- On the palate, wine is dry and burst with ample acidity and sweeter fruit flavors of lemon curd, honeydew melon, and honeycomb with a long finish of minerals, saline, and tingly acidity.
